Instructions for Connecting to the Caltech Conference Network

You now have access to the Caltech Conference Wireless network. Once connected, please open a web browser and go to any web page (such as www.caltech.edu). You'll be redirected to a splash screen that will ask for a username and password. Your credentials are as follows:

Network Name: Caltech Conference

Username: SABMeeting Password: SABMeeting

You will need to login again if your computers goes to sleep.

Access to this Network will begin on 02/04/2016, and be deactivated Midnight 02/05/2016.

A recent feature in some web browsers called OCSP can prevent you from successfully connecting to the Caltech Conference Network. If this feature is available, it should be turned off.

Disable OCSP in Firefox

- Click on the Tools icon to the right of the Location Bar
- 2. Click on Preferences
- 3. Click on Advanced
- 4. Click on Certificates
- 5. Click on Validation
- 6. Uncheck the box labeled 'Use the Online Certificate Status Protocol (OCSP)...
- 7. Click OK
- 8. Click OK or Close

Disable OCSP in Chrome

- Click on the Tools icon to the right of the Location Bar
- 2. Click on Settings
- 3. Click 'Show Advanced Settings...
- 4. In the HTTPS/SSL section, uncheck the box labeled 'Check for server certificate revocation'
- 5. Close the Settings tab

Disable OCSP in Safari

- Launch 'Key Chain Access' app found in /Applications/Utilities
- 2. Click on the 'Keychain Access' Menu
- 3. Choose Preferences
- 4. Click on Certificates
- 5. Click on OCSP
- 6. Choose 'Off'
- 7. Close the window
- 8. Choose 'Quit' from the 'Keychain Access' Menu

There are also some browser extensions available that will prevent the authentication screen from appearing such as 'HTTPS Everywhere'.

These should be disabled for access.
